

Dover Daily Journal obituary index

The *Dover Daily Journal* was published every afternoon except Sunday from August 19, 1895 to May 23, 1896, from offices located at Bergen St. near Blackwell. A local Dover, New Jersey, newspaper, it was delivered by carriers within the incorporated limits of Dover. Subscription rates were one year for \$4.00, six months for \$2.00, three months for \$1.00 and one month for 40 cents.

Proprietor Wilton R. Capps, in the first issue of the newspaper, Monday, August 19, 1895 said, of the newspaper's intended audience and news coverage, *"A medium of daily communication between the people of an enterprising city is something to be desired. Convinced of this fact, the undersigned with this number begins the publication of a daily afternoon newspaper in the town of Dover. Situated in the center of a population of 60,000 people, Dover is the one point from which Morris county news can be quickly disseminated. And to do this will be the mission of the Dover Daily Journal. As regards politics The Journal will be strictly independent. This newspaper will not consider itself bound to uphold the alleged principles of any political party. There are sufficient newspapers engaged in that business, which appear to think they are doing the right thing. The Journal wishes them well, but will endeavor to travel another road to success."*



The last issue of the newspaper was printed on May 23, 1896 and the reason for its suspension was explained in an article on page one by Wilton R. Capps. He wrote: *"The undersigned regrets that he is under the necessity of indefinitely suspending the publication of the Daily Journal. The printing plant which he has used in the publication of the paper is no longer at his disposal for any consideration, and as will be readily understood, a newspaper cannot do business without type and press. The merchants of Dover, while they have given the paper much patronage, appear unwilling or unable to back up the publisher to the extent of obtaining a suitable printing plant, which should be superior in every respect to that which has been used heretofore. The town of Dover needs and is willing to support a daily newspaper, as is evidenced by the columns of the Daily Journal, but modern printing facilities are lacking. It is proper to state that the publisher of the Daily Journal was not notified until Thursday, May 21, at noon, that the printing plant then used by him would not be at his disposal after Saturday*

(today)--less than three days. No publisher, however energetic, could get together a printing plant in such short time. The undersigned returns sincere thanks to those who have patronized the Daily Journal. They realized the need of a daily newspaper and acted accordingly. Dover is a progressive town and ought not to be content with weekly newspapers."

Dover, New Jersey, of 1895-1896 was a progressive, growing city as this *Daily Journal* article of August 21, 1895 reported:

" Facts about Dover: This is a Hustling Town of Many Industries:

Dover is only thirty-nine miles from the City of New York. It is situated on the great double track Delaware, Lackawanna and Western Railroad, which is the shortest route between New York and Buffalo upon the Central Railroad of New Jersey and upon the Morris Canal. All regular passenger trains, on these railroads, stop at the depots in Dover, and 100 such regular passenger trains each week day come to and depart from this place.

One thousand passengers a day get on off these trains at our two stations. We have here 250 different business enterprises, whose monthly wages amount to nearly \$100,000. The capital invested here amounts to about \$6,000,000, which, for a city of a little over five thousand inhabitants is a splendid sum. The assessed valuation of our property is about \$1,000,000.

On an average, daily, some five thousand letters and papers pass through our Post Office. The freight handled daily in Dover amounts to a million pounds. There are 100,000 pounds of meat distributed weekly from this point.

The individual deposits, demand certificates, and certified checks in our Bank amount to about \$514,000, a sum which speaks volumes for the thrift of our people as well as for their confidence in the Bank itself.

There are efficient fire and police departments, excellent telegraph and telephone facilities. The city is lighted by electricity, has macadamized streets, churches of nearly all denominations, admirable schools, an Opera house, good hotels and the best water works in the state, with eighty five pounds pressure in the pipes.

It is a city of homes, an industrial centre, a summer resort, a health emporium, and has possibilities commensurate with the demands and growth of all coming time.

There are three weekly and one daily newspaper (Dover Daily Journal) in this city, and some 1,200 copies of different daily papers are circulated each day in Dover.

These telling facts are their own best commentary on the status and prospects of Dover. As they become known, the place will become more attractive for residence, for business, for investment, for enterprise and for labor."

A Note about the Index

The newspaper carried local and international news. The local news covered surrounding towns with very short news items of deaths, some marriages, hotel visits, local chat, real estate news, business news, injuries and accidents as well as the meetings of local societies. The international news was not consistent in its coverage and could be all types of miscellaneous stories.

This index just covers local news items about deaths in the area surrounding Dover. Also included in the index are news items about injuries or accidents in the local mines or quarries. The names have been copied just as they appear in the newspaper, even if spelling seems to be incorrect. When using the index check use variant spellings to cover all possibilities.
